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Situation of human rights in Eritrea

PP1 *Guided* by the Charter of the United Nations, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the International Covenants on Human Rights and other relevant international human rights instruments [RES 38/15 PP1],

PP2 Recalling resolution 60/251 of the General Assembly, resolutions 5/1 and 5/2 of the Human Rights Council, resolution 91 and decisions 250/2002, 275/2003 and 428/12 of the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights and all previous resolutions on the situation of human rights in Eritrea of the Human Rights Council [based on RES 38/15 PP2 & PP3],

PP3 *Welcoming* the action taken by the Government of Eritrea to protect and promote the economic and social rights of its people, including through the early achievement of the Millennium Development Goals and its commitment to the Sustainable Development Goals, as well as the participation of Eritrea in the third cycle of the universal periodic review on 28 January 2019 [RES 38/15 PP5 updated],

PP4 *Welcoming* the report and the conclusions of the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Eritrea submitted to the Human Rights Council¹,

OP1 Requests the Office of the High Commissioner to present an oral update to the Human Rights Council at its 43rd session on progress made in the cooperation between Eritrea and the Office, and on its impact on the situation of human rights in Eritrea [RES 38/15 OP17];

OP2 *Decides* to extend the mandate of the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Eritrea for a further period of one year, to continue to assess and report on the situation of human rights in follow-up to the report A/HRC/41/53 and requests the Special Rapporteur to present an oral update at its 43rd session during an interactive dialogue and to present a report on the implementation of the mandate to the Human Rights Council at its 44th session during an interactive dialogue and to the General Assembly at its 75th session during an interactive dialogue [RES 38/15 OP12, 13, 14, 15 merged];

OP3 *Calls upon* the Government of Eritrea to cooperate fully with the Special Rapporteur, including by granting access to the country [RES 38/15 OP16] ;

OP4 *Requests* the Secretary-General to provide the Special Rapporteur with all the information and resources necessary to fulfil the mandate [RES 38/15 OP22];

OP5 *Decides* to remain seized of the matter [RES 38/15 OP23].
